QUALIFICATION / RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

*** PLEASE READ THIS * ***

1st, 2nd, 3rd & 4th prize winners in classes 11; the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placed Overall and the three highest placed Restricted animals (if eligible) in classes 5, 7, 10 & 12; the 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed Overall and the four highest placed Restricted animals (if eligible) in classes 4, 6 & 13 will qualify for the 2011 B.S.P.S. Winter Championship Show, provided the animal is registered before the date of the show at which they qualify for the Winter Championships and are ridden by a B.S.P.S. Member, except in the case of exhibitors who have never been members before who are allowed 7 days in which to become members and register their ponies, providing they have a valid J.M.B. Certificate before the date of the Championship they qualify for.

Any animal that has qualified for the SP/SHP/Heritage classes at the R.I.H.S., H.O.Y.S or OLYMPIA 2009, or the current year, is not eligible for the Restricted SP/SHP/Heritage qualification in the Open SP/SHP/Heritage classes. Riders on Restricted animals to enter the ring wearing a WHITE armband.

B.S.P.S. AREA 11 MEMBERS ROSETTE: A member's rosette will be awarded to the highest placed Area 11 member. Riders to enter the ring wearing a red armband.

CLASSES WILL BE PRIMARILY RUN UNDER THE RULES OF THE B.S.P.S. WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CLASSES 14-23 & DRESSAGE CLASSES A & B WHERE NPS RULES WILL APPLY

- 1) This show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (B.S.P.S.) and all persons competing, showing or otherwise taking part in the B.S.P.S. Classes, whether or not members of the B.S.P.S., are subject to the Constitution and Rules of the B.S.P.S., including any disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the B.S.P.S. All rules as per the 2010 B.S.P.S. Rule & Show Handbook, except for any new or amended rules as included in this schedule.
- 2) Correctly secured British Riding Hats PAS015, EN1384 (USA) ASTM F11163 that meet current Safety Standard MUST be worn by riders at all times when mounted.
- 3) The Committee shall not be responsible for any injury, loss or damage to any person, animal or property whatsoever and all those attending the Show in whatever capacity acknowledge this.
- 4) The Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry, amalgamate, split, cancel or move classes to another ring as they deem fit.
- 5) Heritage classes 10 - 13 will be judged under B.S.P.S. Heritage rules. Riders in classes 11 & 13 may be any age except with regard to stallions. Riders must be 12 years old or over on 1st January in the current year to ride stallions not exceeding 138cms or small breed stallions, i.e. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A and Section B. Riders must be 14 years and over on the 1st January in the current year to ride stallions exceeding 138cms or large breed stallions, i.e. Welsh Section C & D, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Connemara.
- 6) This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes (classes 14 – 23 & Dressage classes A & B) will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to members and non-members of the NPS, but non-members will need to become adult showing members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2011.
- 7) Riders in NPS classes 18 - 23 may be any age except with regard to stallions. Riders must be 11 years old or over on 1st January in the current year to ride stallions in the Ridden Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, Welsh Section A and Section B classes. Riders must be 14 years and over on the 1st January in the current year to ride stallions in Ridden Welsh Section C, Section D, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Connemara Classes.
- 8) Disputes must be made in writing to the Secretary's Office within 15 minutes of the end of the class, with a deposit of £20.00, which will be refunded if the objection is upheld. Such disputes will be settled by three members of the Show Committee as appointed by the Chairman. Any disputes under J.M.B. rules must be dealt with in accordance with J.M.B. rules.
- 9) COMPETITORS MUST ABIDE BY THE PARKING STEWARD / STEWARDS INSTRUCTIONS, ANY COMPETITOR FAILING TO COMPLY WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE SHOWGROUND AND THEIR ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED.
- 10) No refund of entry fees will be made except on cancellation of the show.

CLASS 1 **RIDDEN PART BRED** - Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height / type. Riders any age, but must be of a suitable size for the horse. The judge will not ride animals in this class.

CLASS 2 **RIDDEN SHOW HORSE** - Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms. Riders any age, but must be of a suitable size for the horse. The judge will not ride animals in this class.

CLASS 3 **RIDDEN COLOURED** - Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, any height / type. Riders any age, but must be of a suitable size for the horse. The judge will not ride animals in this class.

CLASS 4 **BSPS MIXED HEIGHT OPEN (RESTRICTED) SHOW PONY** – Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 148cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of pony they ride.

CLASS 5 **OPEN (RESTRICTED) INTERMEDIATE SHOW RIDING TYPE** – Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 146cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders must not have attained their 25th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year.

CLASS 6 **BSPS MIXED HEIGHT OPEN (RESTRICTED) SHOW HUNTER PONY** – Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 153cms. Riders must be the correct age for the height of pony they ride.

CLASS 7 **BSPS OPEN (RESTRICTED) INTERMEDIATE SHOW HUNTER TYPE** – Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 148cms but not exceeding 158cms. Riders must not have attained their 25th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year.

SHOW PONY / SHOW HUNTER CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 4 to 7

Class 7 will not commence before 1.00pm

CLASS 8 **LEADING REIN** – Mare or gelding, any type, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders to be 9 years and under.

CLASS 9 **FIRST RIDDEN** – Mare or gelding, any type, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 133cms. Riders to be 12 years and under.

MINI CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to the 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 9 to 12

CLASS 10 **BSPS HERITAGE M&M OPEN (RESTRICTED) LEADING REIN** – Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 122cms. Riders must not have attained their 9th birthday before 1st Jan. in current year.

CLASS 11 **BSPS HERITAGE M&M NOVICE RIDDEN** – Mixed breeds. Ponies 4 years and over. Riders any age.

CLASS 12 **BSPS HERITAGE M&M OPEN (RESTRICTED) FIRST RIDDEN** – Mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, not exceeding 128cms. Riders must not have attained their 12th birthday before 1st Jan. in current year. Any suitable bridle permitted.

CLASS 13 **BSPS HERITAGE M&M OPEN (RESTRICTED) RIDDEN** – Mixed breeds. Ponies 4 years and over. Riders any age.

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and in the following classes the NPS General Rules for Showing apply. These classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become Adult Showing members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2011.

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2010/2011 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2011 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions.

CLASS 14 NPS/CHECKLEYBANK M&M NOVICE LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – Mixed M&M Lead Rein pony, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 122cms, registered in the pure bred section of breed societies stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A or B. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not have attained 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein should be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hand. Not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Classification

CLASS 15 NPS / CHECKLEYBANK M&M NOVICE FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – Mixed M&M First Ridden pony, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 128cms, registered in the pure bred section of breed societies stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A or B. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not have attained 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Any suitable bridle is acceptable Not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Classification

Class 16 NPS/T.C. TACK & THINGS M&M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – Mixed M&M Lead Rein pony, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 122cms, registered in the pure bred section of breed societies stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A or B. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not have attained 9th birthday before 1st January in the current year. To be shown in a snaffle bridle, the lead rein should be attached to the noseband only. The reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hand.

CLASS 17 NPS/KBIS M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – Mixed M&M First Ridden pony, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, not exceeding 128cms, registered in the pure bred section of breed societies stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A or B. Riders must have attained their 3rd birthday but not have attained 12th birthday before 1st January in the current year. Any suitable bridle is acceptable.

NPS WINTER SERIES MINI CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to 1st and 2nd prize winners from classes 14 to 17

CLASS 18 NPS / HIRSTMUND STUD M&M PURE NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP - Mixed M&M ridden stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, registered in the pure bred section of the breed societies stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A or B. Riders any age. Pony not to have been placed first in any Ridden M&M class prior to the commencement of the current Winter Series. All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bridle.

Class 19 NPS / HIRSTMUND STUD M&M PURE NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP - Mixed M&M ridden stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, registered in the pure bred section of the breed societies stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest and Welsh Section C or D. Riders any age. Pony not to have been placed first in any Ridden M&M class prior to the commencement of the current Winter Series. All ponies in this class must be shown in a snaffle bridle.

Class 19 will not commence before 1.00pm

CLASS 20 NPS / FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – Mixed M&M ridden stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, registered in the pure bred section of the breed societies stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A or B. Riders any age. Not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Classification. Ponies are to be shown in any suitable bridle.

CLASS 21 NPS / FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – Mixed M&M ridden stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, registered in the pure bred section of the breed societies stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest and Welsh Section C or D. Riders any age. Not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Classification. Ponies are to be shown in any suitable bridle.

CLASS 22 NPS / SNUGGY HOODS M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – Mixed M&M ridden stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, registered in the pure bred section of the breed societies stud books of Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A or B. Riders any age.

CLASS 23 NPS / SNUGGY HOODS M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP – Mixed M&M ridden stallion, mare or gelding, 4 years or over, registered in the pure bred section of the breed societies stud books of Connemara, Dales, Fell, Highland, New Forest and Welsh Section C or D. Riders any age.

OUTDOOR ARENA 2

NATIONAL PONY SOCIETY/TopSpec DRESSAGE TRIAL

A new competition to encourage both performance and education of British bred ponies and their riders. Qualifiers will run from April 2010 and culminate in the **NPS/TopSpec Supreme Dressage Championship Final** to be held at the prestigious show venue Addington Manor Equestrian Centre, Addington, Buckinghamshire in April 2011 – date to be confirmed. Stabling will be available.

The competition will run under British Dressage Rules during 2010 transferring to amended NPS Dressage Rules in 2011 and be judged by British Dressage Judges using **British Dressage Tests 14 & 28** throughout. Each test will consist of five sections all of which will have their own Final.

The two highest placed ponies in each section at each qualifying show will qualify for the 2011 Final.

Sections are open to:-

1. **Registered Mountain & Moorland breeds not exceeding 138cm**
2. **Registered Mountain & Moorland breeds exceeding 138cm**
3. **Registered British Riding Ponies**
4. **Part Bred Horses/Ponies registered with their appropriate Native Breed Part Bred Stud Book**
5. **Highest placed rider aged under 12 years on 1st January 2010**

* Part Bred Native ponies over-stamped within the British Riding Pony Stud Book may only compete in one section per season.

Qualifying rounds will be open to everyone from across the UK.

- All qualifiers will receive Sponsors rosettes and cards.
- Horse/ponies **must** be ridden at the Final by the qualifying rider.
- Those qualifying for the Final must be fully paid up Dressage or Showing members of the NPS for 2011 in order to compete at the 2011 NPS/TopSpec Final.

The Champion winners of each section Final for each Test will be required to perform a 4.5 minute freestyle to Music for the judging of the Overall NPS/TopSpec Supreme Dressage titles.

Please Note: The NPS/TopSpec Supreme Dressage Final will run in accordance with the 2011 NPS Dressage Rules, which will be available to all NPS Dressage and Showing Members

CLASS A **PRELIM 14** – Please state qualification section (1-4) and age of rider if applicable on entry form.

Commencing 1.00pm Prompt

CLASS B **NOVICE 28** – Please state qualification section (1-4) and age of rider if applicable on entry form.

Leave A34 north of Winchester at Three Maids Hill Roundabout (A272/B3420), left onto Andover Road north towards Winchester, first right onto Harestock Road, right onto Stockbridge Road (B3049), left at Sparsholt College sign (4 miles from A34). From Salisbury/Stockbridge take the B3049 from Stockbridge towards Winchester. Sparsholt College is approx 6 miles on the right.
