At Area 13b they were 3rd in the

PP RIHS SHP, 2nd in the open 133 SHP and went brilliantly to win the RIHS Open 133 SHP. It made that long drive to Taunton, and the sweltering heat, so worthwhile. Our Area 11 show was a great day. Barney won three classes, the PP RIHS SP, the PP RIHS SHP and the novice SHP. Floss was 5th in the mixed height WHP and then won the open mixed height M&M. At the following day's PC show both ponies were well placed in all their SJ and WHP classes, and Floss rounded off proceedings by winning the gymkhana championship. Great fun all round.
